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VALUE AND IMPACT

Visual Standard Work Instructions are primarily used to document a process that has been designed within your operation, but we will show when and how to create them in order to insure an enhanced performance sustainability, and how Work Instructions integrated with photographs can make a bigger impact; reducing training costs, making it easier to rotate employees and capturing tribal knowledge. Visual Standard Work Instructions are also an excellent tool to create department collaboration.

A recent research study revealed that only about 16% of new product launches were introduced with supporting work instruction leaving the process to develop based on assumption ... hence allowing waste to creep into the process and not enabling the organization to meet financial or production run rate targets.

To preserve the physical assets of your operation **Total Productive Maintenance (TPM)** is a powerful tool when properly applied. This will make sure that equipment is predictable and ready for use without any unexpected surprises. This tool builds employee emotional attachment creating ownership and pride in the operation, while protecting the value of your assets and assisting in opening up capacity within your operation quickly.

Standard Work for Leaders is the back bone of insuring Repeatable and Predictable Performance which will pre-determine your financial results. We will show you how to simply align the leadership team to provide predictable results.

Finally, we will conclude to train you on how to use some **Simple Auditing Methodologies** to insure that your tools will deliver the results you desire while at the same time have the tool become more robust over time as your organization evolves along the excellence journey.

Once you implement these basic infrastructure tools and train your folks to follow them intuitively you will be able to harvest greater profitability and cash, as you implement the use of more enhanced tools.
